Patricia studied fine art at the University of Central Lancashire and graduated with honours in 1980.

Her work is held in the House of Lords Art Collection, London, in the Head Office of Cadbury and in private national and international collections in Europe, America, Australia and New Zealand.

Patricia's work is represented by galleries in the North West and shown in exhibitions across the UK, including Newcastle, Edinburgh and London.

In 2004, she was invited to take part in an exhibition in Ömsköldsvik, Sweden.

In 2014 Patricia was shortlisted for the Artists & Illustrators magazine Artist of the year competition with her painting 'The Chemist – Kirkby Lonsdale'. The painting was exhibited in the A&I exhibition at the Mall Galleries, London in January 2015.

"Living by the shores of Morecambe Bay, I witness first-hand the fast-moving weather fronts that sweep over the North West, illuminating or casting shadows over the coast and countryside. It is these dramatic changes in light that excite and inspire me, along with my love of colour.
